Now you always have to bear in mind the difference between a countable and uncountable noun when you need to translate «molto» or «poco»in English:

| A LOT OF <br> or | AFFIRMATIVE | COUNTABLE <br> UNCOUNTABLE | C You have a lot of friends |

| QUANTIFIER «poco/chi/che > | SENTENCES | NOUNS | EXAMPLES |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A little | AFFIRMATIVE NEGATIVE interrogative | UNCOUNTABLE | I. Do you have a little money? <br> N. You don't have a little money |
| Few, a few | AFFIRMATIVE NEGATIVE interrogative | COUNTABLE | I. Do you have few friends? <br> N. You don't have few friends. |
